

## SDBP ANNUAL MEETING POSTER SPECIFICATIONS

A poster presentation consists of research highlights that are visually presented on a moveable display. The area for displaying poster materials is 4 feet high by 4 feet wide.

The poster boards require push pins (that will be provided) for you to display your work.

\* Please do not exceed the 4ft x 4ft space allotted!

Please mount your poster next to your publication/poster number (can be found on the SDBP meetings page website and on-site). Your poster should be put up prior to the start of your assigned poster session and must be taken down according to the meeting schedule. You should stay with your poster during the Meet the Author Session so attendees may confer with you.

Here are a few hints for good poster presentations:

- Make your poster simple and eye-catching.
- Use simple drawings, diagrams, graphs and/or photographs
- Graphics should be explicit and brief
- Have clean and attractive layouts
- Use few panels, including an introduction/summary.
- Simple use of color can add emphasis effectively.
  - The 6 best color combinations are:
  - Black on white
  - Red on white
  - Green on white
  - Blue on white
  - White on blue
  - White on black
- Use large print and a minimum of text
- Your poster should contain headings that organize and logically display the information.
- You may want to create a QR code or bring handouts (450+ attendees are expected).
- Keep abbreviations and jargon to a minimum.
